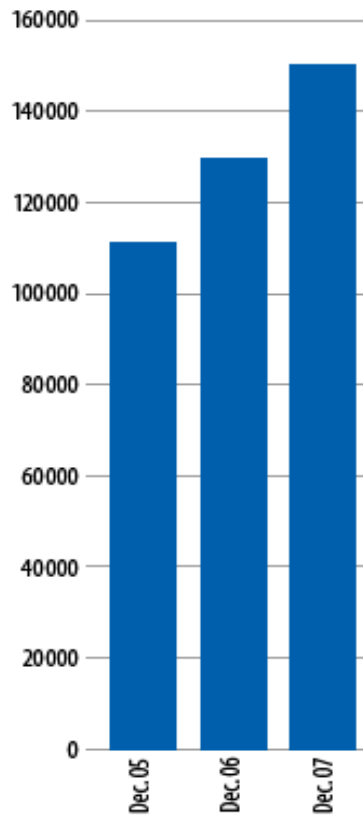

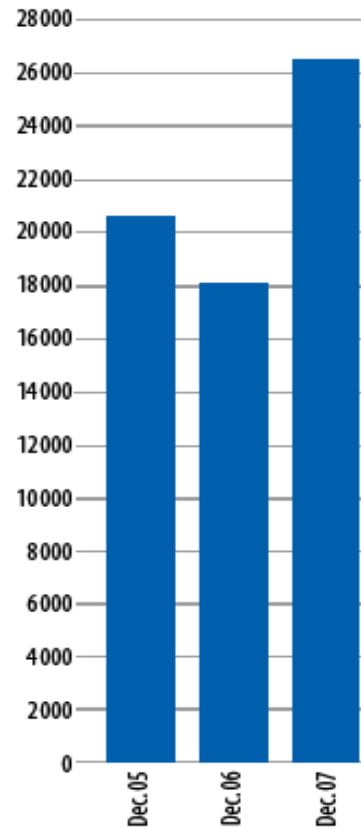

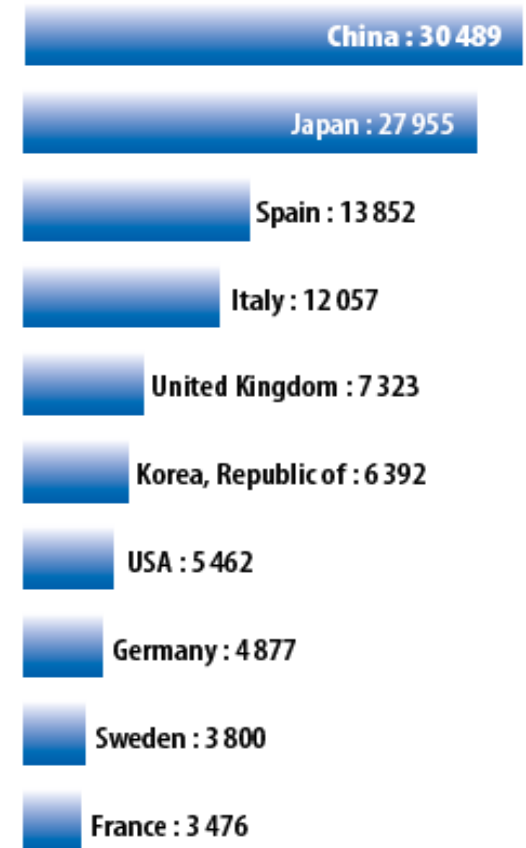
Worldwide total of ISO 14001:2004 certificates December 2005 to December 2007



Annual growth of ISO 14001:2004 certificates December 2005 to December 2007

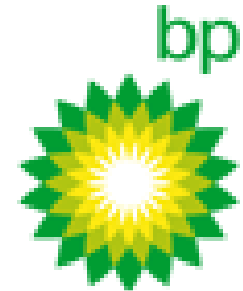


Top 10 countries for ISO 14001:2004 certificates

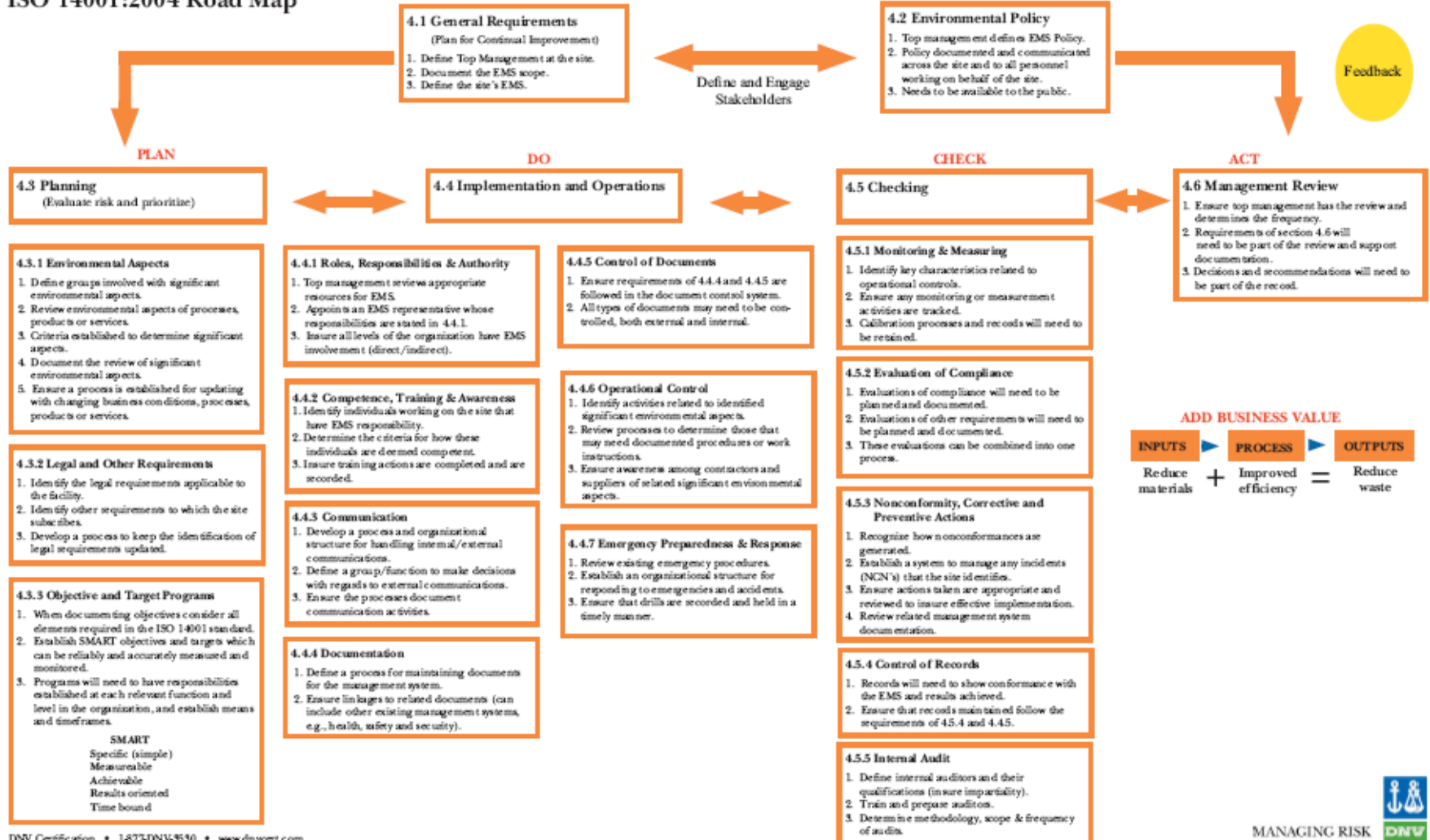

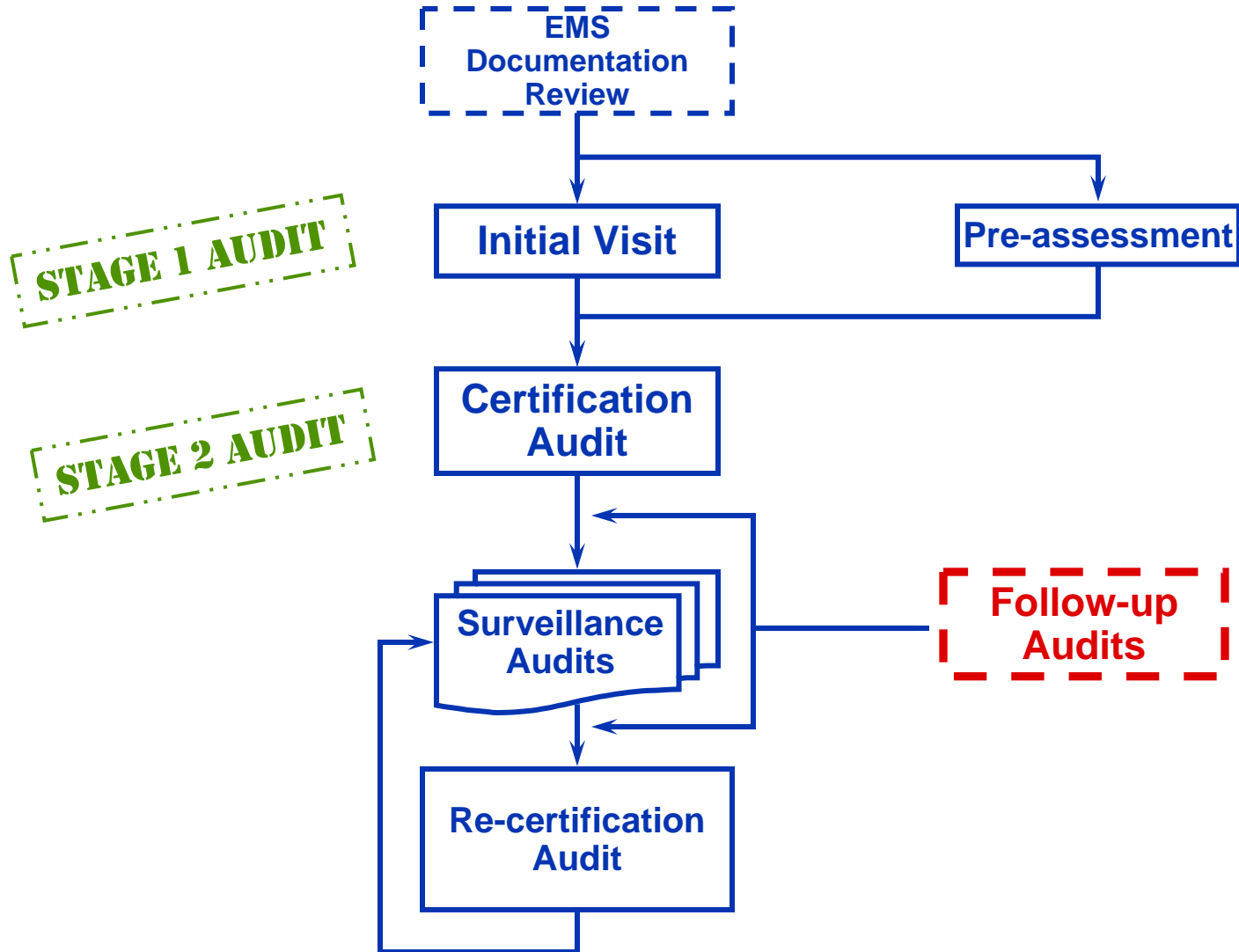




ISO 14001:2004 Road Map



The Certification Process



- **What is the typical cost of registration?**
- **Does 14001 have the same surveillance requirements as AS9100?**
- **Can the AS9100 and ISO 14001 audits be conducted by the same auditor at the same visit?**
- **Does the auditor conduct a conformance or compliance audit or both?**
- **If the auditor observes a regulatory violation, will they or are they required to report this to the appropriate authorities?**
- **With an integrated QMS/EMS is it easier or harder to audit?**
